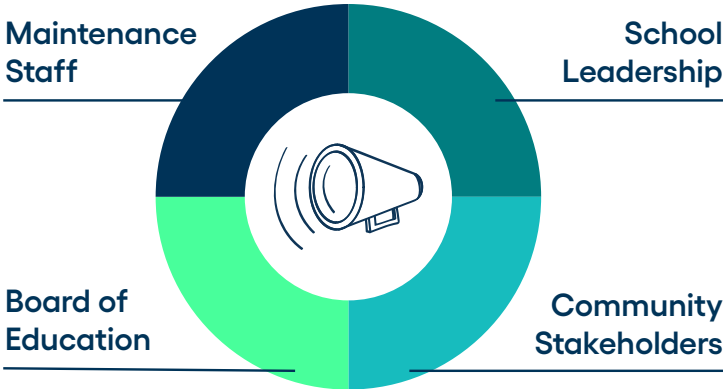




The Role of Asset and Facilities Management in Education Leadership

Effective leadership in facilities management requires clear communication and effective collaboration with maintenance teams, school leadership, community stakeholders, and the Board of Education.

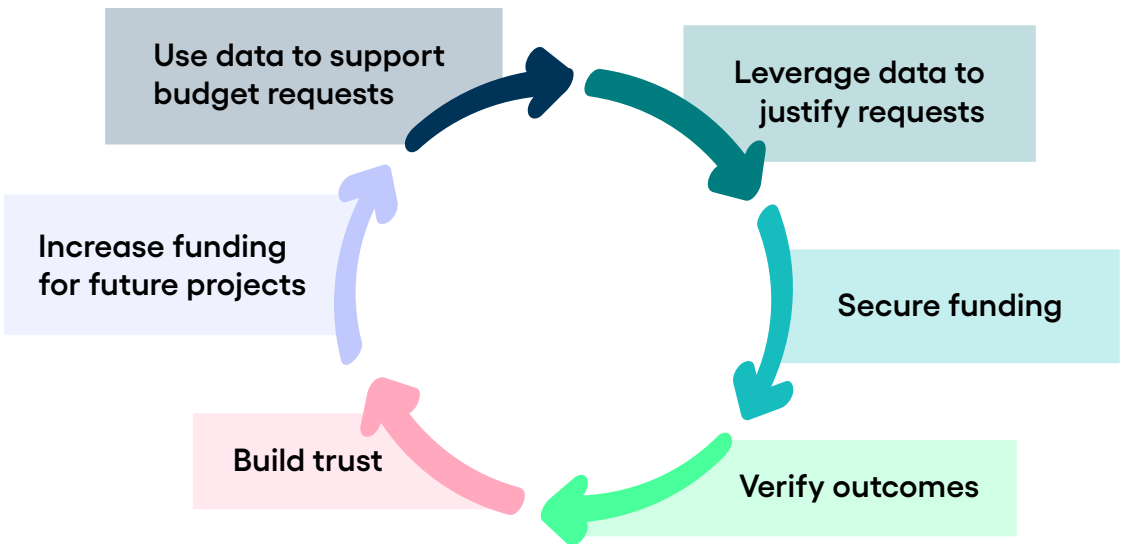


The Importance of Clear Communication

54% of K-12 education leaders say aging infrastructure is a major challenge

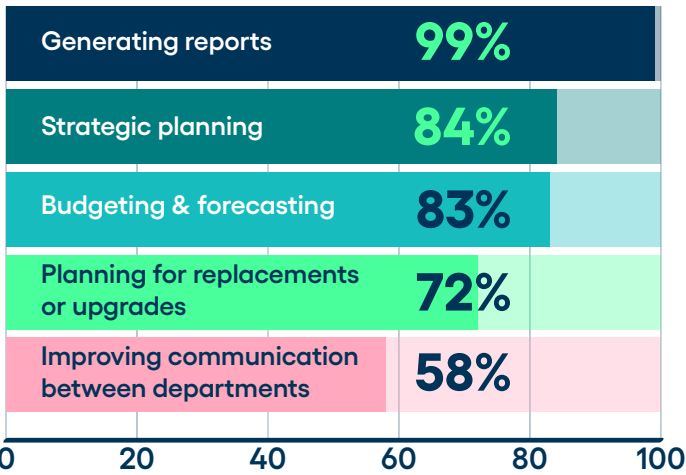
64% of U.S. consumers doubt their local public schools have access to data needed to justify facility upgrades



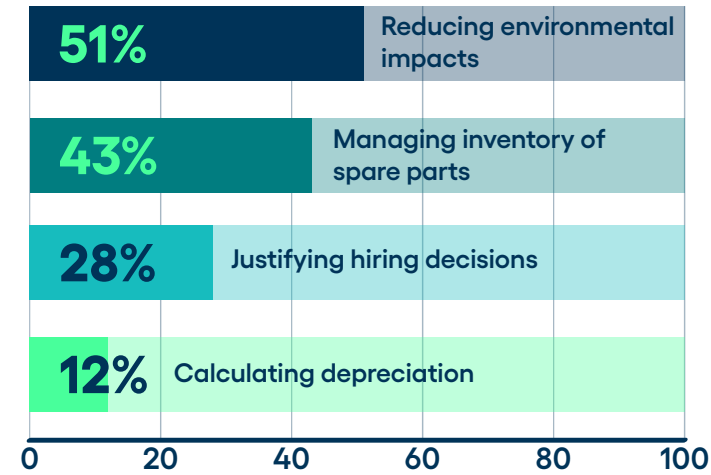
How Asset Management Systems Can Help
